



Wellington High School - Intent to Participate

All students wanting to participate in the College Credit Plus program next year must fill out the **INTENT TO PARTICIPATE** form and return it to the guidance office by April 1.

TIMELINE FOR NEW CCP STUDENTS

1. Attend an informational meeting at WHS or LCCC campus.
2. Complete WHS "Intent to Participate" form and return it to the guidance office by April 1.
3. Submit LCCC College Application as soon as possible.
4. Upon receiving LCCC acceptance letter, make an appointment to take placement tests at LCCC.
5. Research college courses and meet with your counselor to fill out an Authorization Form.
6. Schedule an appoint to meet with your college advisor.

CCP Overview

The College Credit Plus Program (CCP) is a program enacted through HB 487. The following list addresses the potential benefits and risks of the College Credit Plus program. While the list highlights the major benefits and risks, it is by no means exhaustive of the possible benefits and consequences of early college enrollment.

POSSIBLE BENEFITS

- ✓ May expand the curriculum available to a qualified student
- ✓ Provides opportunities for a student to explore "in depth" those areas of special interest
- ✓ Allows a student to earn college credit while in high school
- ✓ Provides financial support for taking college courses, earning both high school credit and possible transferrable college credit
- ✓ Allows a student to experience college-level work/life prior to making final decisions about whether and/or where to attend college

POSSIBLE RISKS

- ✓ Will increase a student's responsibility for extended learning in an academically challenging environment
- ✓ May reduce opportunities for participating in high school activities, and cause student to miss important school related information unless he/she makes a point to actively seek out important emails and announcements
- ✓ Will result in a financial obligation to the student or parent if student who is taking the course for high school credit fails the course, withdraws from the course, or fails to complete the course
- ✓ Transportation is the responsibility of the family
- ✓ Will result in a student not qualifying to graduate if the student fails or drops a course which is either a course or credit required for graduation
- ✓ May result in a possible schedule conflict between high school courses and college courses
- ✓ All coursework may not transfer to some universities. Please visit www.transfer.org
- ✓ May result in different calendar dates between college and high school
- ✓ Could affect athletic eligibility

SPECIAL NOTES

- ✓ Grades for CCP courses taken for high school credit will be computed into your GPA. The grade will only be weighted when an Honors/AP course in that subject area is also offered at the high school.
- ✓ After April 1st, the longer a student waits to follow through with the application, testing, and registration process at his/her chosen CCP institution, the more likely it will be that class sections at the high school and college will be full, possibly keeping the student from being able to participate in the program.
