Nutrition Services update

The Nutrition Services Department is pleased to welcome your child(ren) to the 2022-2023 school year! We continue to strive to make the meals offered at all of our district schools, whole grain rich and full of locally sourced fruits and vegetables, when available. Please encourage your child(ren) to select and consume all of the offered options to ensure they are getting the most balanced meal available.

This month the Nutrition Services Department transitioned to operating procedures in place prior to March 2022. This means that Breakfast and Lunch will still be available to all students, however, meals will not be free to all students. Families who feel that they may meet income guidelines should complete the Free and Reduced-Price applications. Applications can be printed from our website, filled out online at <https://www.payschoolscentral.com/> or picked up in the school or the Board of Education office. Applications can be filed at any time throughout the school year. Please keep that in mind should your financial situation change at any point. These applications are also used for fee waivers and district funding.
