Policies, Practices, and Procedures:

1. Identify students who are at-risk of dropping out of high school.
2. Identify students with disabilities that are at-risk of dropping out of high school.
3. Annually updating and monitoring graduation tracking tool for all students.
4. Annual dropout prevention team meetings held quarterly.
5. Effective PBIS systems at the middle school and high school to increase student engagement.
6. Currently exploring attendance incentive programs districtwide to increase student attendance and engagement.-Goal to implement 2025-2026 school year.
7. Implementing alternative pathways for at risk students and graduation (i.e. Career Based Interventions (CBI), virtual placements, and alternative placements).
8. Building principals, school counselors, and Student Services Department meet annually to monitor and support at-risk students grades 6-12.
9. Tracking student attendance, behavior, and academic performance of students at-risk of dropping and/or not graduating from high school.
